Appropriate candidates include stepdowns from higher intensity services, high-risk alternative sentencing, patients with a high-risk for relapse, patients requiring additional stabilization

Initial Services

- ⌋ Comprehensive psychiatric evaluation
- ⌋ Nursing assessment
- ⌋ Laboratory testing
- ⌋ Full panel drug screen
- ⌋ Development of treatment plan

Core Therapeutic Services

- ⌋ 12 hours group therapy weekly, including psycho-educational lectures
- ⌋ 2 hours specialty group weekly
- ⌋ 2 hours family group weekly

Medical Services

- ⌋ 4 one-hour visits with psychiatrist monthly, including initial evaluation
- ⌋ Random urine drug screening*

Flexible Therapeutic Services

- ⌋ 3 hours Care Management Sessions weekly (individual therapy, outside therapy, family therapy, recovery coaching, etc.)
- ⌋ 3 hours holistic interventions weekly (massage, yoga, personal training, etc.)

Initial Services

- ⌋ Comprehensive psychiatric evaluation
- ⌋ Nursing assessment
- ⌋ Laboratory testing
- ⌋ Full panel drug screen
- ⌋ Development of treatment plan

Core Therapeutic Services

- ⌋ 9 hours group therapy weekly, including psycho-educational lectures
- ⌋ 1-2 hours specialty group weekly
- ⌋ 2 hours family group weekly

Medical Services

- ⌋ 2 one-hour visits with psychiatrist monthly, including initial evaluation
- ⌋ Random urine drug screening*

Flexible Therapeutic Services

- ⌋ 3 hours Care Management Sessions weekly (individual therapy, outside therapy, family therapy, recovery coaching, etc.)
- ⌋ 2 hours holistic interventions weekly (massage, yoga, personal training, etc.)

Core Therapeutic Services

- ⌋ 9 hours group therapy weekly, including psycho-educational lectures
- ⌋ 2 hours family group weekly

Medical Services

- ⌋ 1 one-hour visit with psychiatrist monthly, including initial evaluation
- ⌋ Random urine drug screening*

Flexible Therapeutic Services

- ⌋ 2 hours Care Management Sessions weekly (individual therapy, outside therapy, family therapy, recovery coaching, etc.)
- ⌋ 1 hour holistic intervention weekly (massage, yoga, personal training, etc.)

Additional Services

- ⌋ Once monthly four-hour family education program and multi-family group

Patients must be admitted for a minimum of 30 days and treatment services are extended at monthly increments thereafter.

*Urine drug screen monitoring is a contracted service billed to your medical insurance plan. Monitoring fees for cash pay patients are added to treatment costs on a sliding scale basis.
